All transfer applications to the Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth- or Sixth-Year Groups in Saint Joseph's Community College other than to the Special Class, will only be accepted after the 05/01/2026 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 06/02/2026. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore,
